



## 2010 NFCC Be Money Wise National Poster Contest

### Rules and Guidelines

#### Theme

“Smart Money Choices = A Brighter Future”

#### Eligibility

The 2010 NFCC National Poster Contest will feature three grade categories:

Elementary – 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grades

Middle – 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> Grades

High – 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grades

#### Specifications

Posters may be between 8 ½” by 11” and 11” by 17” in size (11” by 17” is preferred.) All posters must be submitted on white paper/stock. **Original and computer-generated artwork is accepted.**

#### Labeling

To be eligible, all posters must have an official NFCC Entry Form attached to the back of poster. “NA” (not applicable) can be used where needed. (See next page for form. Duplicate as needed.)

#### Deadline

#### Judging

Posters will be judged on expression of the theme (40%); artwork style and content (30%); and creativity (30%).

GreenPath will present awards to first place and runner up in each grade category. First place winners from each grade category will be sent to the NFCC as National Finalists to be judged for national honors.

#### Prizes

GreenPath will award **first place winners** in each age category with a \$100 savings bond and a \$50 Barnes & Noble gift card; the **runner-up** in each age category will receive a \$25 Barnes & Noble gift card.

All national finalists will receive a commemorative t-shirt. National grade category winners will receive an award plaque and a \$100 savings bond. National overall winner will receive an award plaque, a \$500 savings bond, and an all-expense paid trip (includes travel, lodging, and meals) with a parent or guardian to Washington, DC to be presented with their national award in April as part of Financial Literacy Month. **Winner must be able to come to Washington, DC on the dates given by the NFCC; otherwise, trip will be rewarded to runner-up.**
